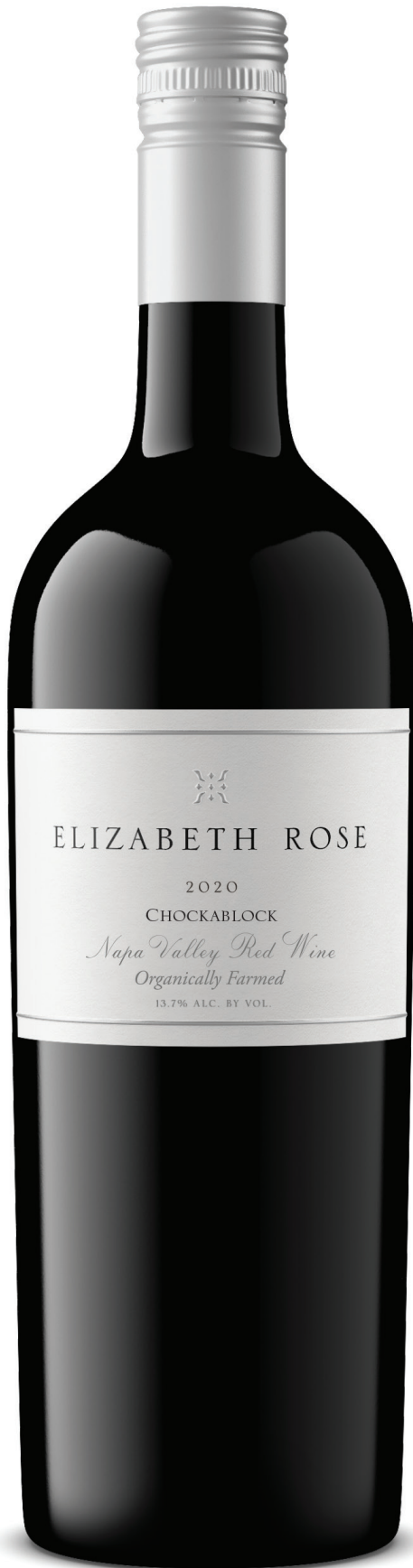




ELIZABETH ROSE

2020 CHOCKABLOCK RED WINE

NAPA VALLEY



VINEYARD NOTES

The fruit for this blend is sourced from both our Block House and Mill Race Vineyards in the Yountville appellation of Napa Valley. Block House is a 292-acre vineyard that contains 14 different varieties. This vineyard tends to benefit from the cooling winds originating from San Pablo Bay. The row orientation for this vineyard is Northeast-Southwest. Chockablock utilizes Malbec, Merlot, and Cabernet Sauvignon from Block House. Mill Race is a 35.57-acre vineyard located across the Napa River from Block House. The Cabernet Sauvignon planted at this vineyard is also incorporated into this blend. The growing degree days accumulated by Mill Race are typically 10% higher than at Block House. Mill Race also has a North-South row orientation, exposing the fruit to more sunlight, resulting in a different style of Cabernet Sauvignon compared to Block House. Both of these properties are family-owned and certified-organic.

WINEMAKER NOTES

2020 vintage marks the 6th vintage of this beautiful wine that started as a Merlot dominant red wine blend. This vintage offers incredibly perfumed aromas of rose, violet, strawberry, red cherry, black plum, and hints of white pepper, vanilla, chocolate, and coffee. On the palate, beautiful balance, medium body texture with firm fine-grained tannins resulting in an extraordinary mouthfeel. In addition, it displays an outstanding long finish with bright acidity.
