VINEYARD NOTES

Rosé is a blend composed of three organically farmed varietals: Cinsault, Grenache, and Syrah. The Cinsault and Grenache are 13-year-old vines from 2-acres of our Rock Cairn Vineyard in Oakville, Napa Valley. The Syrah was planted to a 5-acre block in 2002 at our Block House Vineyard in Yountville, Napa Valley. All three of these varietals are organically farmed and harvested for optimal Rosé production.

WINEMAKER NOTES

Emulating a Provence-style Rosé, this classic blend of Cinsault, Syrah, and Grenache made by our Winemaker Jeff Onysko is a beautiful wine with perfumy aromas of grapefruit, fresh-cut watermelon, strawberry, and rose petals. Follow through on the palate with flavors of raspberry, pomegranate, and tart citrus, with a medium body and a perky, crispy finish; this wine invites you to sit down on the patio on a sunny day and enjoy this bottle by itself or with a delicious smoked salmon crostini on the side.
