Our Elizabeth Rose Pinot Noir grapes thrive in the sprawling expanse of Block House, our largest vineyard spanning 292 acres. Located on the valley floor, Block House benefits from the refreshing influence of the San Pablo Bay breeze, creating optimal conditions for the cultivation and maturation of Pinot Noir. This particular Pinot Noir is an exquisite blend, combining the distinct characteristics of the Dijon and Wente clones. Remarkably, nearly 20% of Block House is exclusively devoted to the cultivation of these exceptional Pinot Noir grapes.

WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2022 Elizabeth Rose Pinot Noir welcomes you with intense aromas of ripe cherry and raspberry, accompanied by notes of orange peel and delicate floral hints of violets and roses, adding to the complexity of earthy undertones. On the palate, it showcases vibrant and tangy cherry flavors that bring a refreshing burst with every sip. The supple tannins provide a smooth mouthfeel, enhancing the wine's overall elegance. For a delightful food pairing, consider enjoying this beautiful Pinot Noir with Duck Roast complemented by a cherry sauce.
