The Cinsault and Grenache grapes, both aged 13 years, thrive on a 2-acre parcel within our esteemed Rock Cairn Vineyard, nestled in the heart of Oakville, Napa Valley. Meanwhile, the Syrah vines were meticulously planted in a 5-acre block back in 2003, gracing our Block House Vineyard in Yountville, Napa Valley. It's worth noting that all three of these exceptional grape varietals are cultivated using organic farming practices, ensuring that each harvest is optimized for the production of our exquisite Rosé.

2023 Elizabeth Rose Rosé, a captivating wine boasting a stunning salmon hue. This delightful wine beckons you with enticing scents reminiscent of sun-ripened strawberries, luscious raspberries, and a subtle hint of orange peel, all enhanced by a touch of spice from the Syrah grape.
