




ELIZABETH ROSE

2023 CHOCKABLOCK RED WINE

NAPA VALLEY



VINEYARD NOTES

The fruit for Elizabeth Rose Chockablock is sourced from both our Block House and Mill Race Vineyards in the Yountville appellation of Napa Valley. Block House Vineyard, where we source Merlot, Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon, is a 292-acre vineyard with deep alluvial soils and cooling winds originating from San Pablo Bay. Mill Race, a 35-acre vineyard, is located at the northern end of Yountville at the Oakville boarder. This is our warmest vineyard, with growing degree days typically 10% higher than at Block House and the north-south row orientation, exposes the fruit to more sunlight, resulting in a different style of Cabernet Sauvignon than from Block House Vineyard. The blend of these two vineyard sites gives the wine depth and complexity. Both vineyards are family-owned and certified-organic.

WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2023 Elizabeth Rose Chockablock showcases remarkable balance and depth. Aromas of black cherry, blackberry and cocoa intertwine with gentle caramel notes. The palate is well-structured and balanced offering supple tannins, bright acidity and a clean, refined finish. Elegant yet approachable, this wine over delivers for its price point and will continue to evolve beautifully over the next five to seven years under screw cap, preserving its freshness and finesse.
