VINEYARD NOTES

The 2024 Elizabeth Rose Pinot Noir comes from our Block House Vineyard, a 292-acre estate on the Napa Valley floor cooled by San Pablo Bay breezes—ideal for slow, even Pinot Noir ripening. Planted to Dijon and Wente clones, with nearly 20% of the vineyard dedicated to Pinot Noir, the 2024 growing season delivered balanced conditions that preserved natural acidity and allowed vibrant, expressive flavors to develop.

WINEMAKER NOTES

Opens with lifted, fruit-forward aromatics, immediately expressive and bright. On the palate, it leans less earthy than earlier vintages, showcasing pure red fruit with clarity and freshness rather than savory or mushroom-driven notes. Juicy strawberry leads the profile, followed closely by cherry—ranging from classic Rainier cherry to moments of brightness that recall a slightly sweet cherry character. The fruit feels fresh and vibrant, giving the wine an approachable, polished style. There's a soft, silky texture through the mid-palate, with balanced acidity that keeps everything lively and clean.
